

Directions

Spanish Landing is on the South side of Harbor Drive directly across from the exit from Terminal 2 of the San Diego International Airport. From I-5 follow signs to the Airport. This will place you on Harbor Drive. Go past Terminal 1 and Harbor Drive traffic signals and watch for the Spanish Landing signs. Turn left into the park at the traffic signal for the exit from Terminal 2. There will be San Diego Jaguar Club Signs and balloons marking the spot.
